

# The Vodafone Dmax 2013 Championships Round 9

### Daytona Milton Keynes – Extended Cliff Circuit – Heats

As the championship returned to Daytona Milton Keynes, the drivers faced a new track layout, with the Cliff Chicane included for the first time ever at a Vodafone Dmax race. Heavy rain showers through the morning and almost constant rain in the afternoon added to the challenge!

## Heat 1

**Inters:** Tim McKeegan led the field into turn 1 as James Pratt moved up the order to be sitting in 2<sup>nd</sup> after the first few corners. Joe Holmes was into 4<sup>th</sup> as the field disappeared down the hill with 4<sup>th</sup> becoming 3<sup>rd</sup> come the hairpin at turn 10 as Holmes passed Alec Tucker. Pratt hit the front at the end of lap 1 and quickly started to get away, leaving McKeegan behind him with Holmes and Tucker a few kart lengths behind in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. These 4 were well clear of Anthony Ford in 5<sup>th</sup> by the end of lap 2 as Pratt continued to edge away; his lead at 3.613 seconds after 3 laps. Tucker was coming back at Holmes as the rain started to come down yet again, getting the gap back down to 0.641 seconds. Pratt continued to build on his lead, starting the final lap with a 5.111 second advantage over McKeegan, Holmes and Tucker who were all circulating together. Pratt won by 5.664 seconds from McKeegan, Holmes, Tucker and Ford.

**Heavies:** Ian Dutfield got off to a good start, leading the field through the first few corners and got a bit of a gap by the time the field descended down the hill for the first time. Chris Carter made his way through the pack on the opening lap to 2<sup>nd</sup>, then closed the gap and passed Dutfield for the lead before the lap's completion. Robert Bennett was into 3<sup>rd</sup> on lap 1 and began to put Dutfield under pressure before passing him into the final corner. This tussle allowed Carter to get a break and a lead of 2.964 seconds after 2 laps. Michael McKeegan was next to challenge Dutfield, passing him on lap 3 with Vincent doing likewise to move into 4<sup>th</sup>. 4<sup>th</sup> became 2<sup>nd</sup> on lap 4 for Vincent as he







passed McKeegan and Bennett, but it was too late to catch Carter who won from Vincent by 6.359. Bennett took 3<sup>rd</sup> just beating Munro and George Dutfield.

**Lights:** Josh King shot off at the start followed by Marc Coltelli and Ryan Ould. King's lead was short lived however, as he and Coltelli met in the middle at turn 2, causing King to slide wide. James Baldwin was soon into the lead with Coltelli behind him and now Chris Hackworth. Coltelli then had a spin coming out of 5 having turned in on Hackworth causing the kart to stall and being collected dropping himself and leader Baldwin down the order. This left Hackworth in the lead with a gap over Johnny Spencer another gap back to Ben Leslie in 3<sup>rd</sup>. Hackworth edged away from Spencer, starting the final lap with a gap of 5.968 seconds with the full course yellow being brought out on the final lap to retrieve a stricken kart. The green flag was shown for the final half a lap with Hackworth taking the win from Spencer, Leslie, Steve Moody and Dominic Tucker.

### Heat 2

**Inters:** Joe Holmes held on around the outside of Wolfgan Reip to take the lead going into turn 2, with Reip following him out as the rest of the field jostled for position. Alec Tucker was heading the rest of the field at the end of lap 1, having closed in on Reip to challenge for 2<sup>nd</sup> and leaing Anthony Ford and Elliot Stafford to fight over 4<sup>th</sup>. Holmes was getting away at the front as Reip held off Tucker whilst James Pratt closed in on the pair of them in 4<sup>th</sup>. Pratt caught Reip and Tucker on lap 3 as Tucker passed Reip with Pratt quickly doing the same to take 3<sup>rd</sup> and challenge Tucker for 2<sup>nd</sup>. Pratt got ahead to take 2<sup>nd</sup> on lap 4, but by this stage, Holmes was 6.546 seconds up the road. Holmes took the chequered flag from Pratt by 6.893 seconds with Tucker narrowly beating Reip to 3<sup>rd</sup>. Ford completed the top 5.

**Heavies:** Chris Munro held off George Dutfield as the green flag was waved with Jack Dutfied a few kart lengths behind in 3<sup>rd</sup>. David Vincent and Ian Brooks made their way through some spun karts at turn 5 to take up 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> repectively as Munro and George Dutfield began to get away at the front. Brooks and Vincent soon caught Jack Dutfield ahead of them to make it a 3 kart-train for 3<sup>rd</sup> by the end of Iap 2. Chris Carter was running in 6<sup>th</sup>, albeit 3.625 seconds behind the 3 in front of him but gained a place after Brooks spun out at turn 10 hairpin having just passed Jack Dutfield for 3<sup>rd</sup> going into turn 9. Vincent took 3<sup>rd</sup> on Iap 3 as Carter closed in on Jack Dutfield behind him. Munro had a lead of 0.971 seconds over George Dutfield on the penultimate Iap, but as they disappeared down the hill, it was George Dutfield that led Munro coming back up the hill as they started the final Iap. Munro regained







1<sup>st</sup> on the final lap as George Dutfield spun at turn 5. This left Munro with a very comfortable lead to the chequered flag. George Dutfield took 2<sup>nd</sup> from Vincent 3<sup>rd</sup>, Carter 4<sup>th</sup> and Brooks 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Lights:** James Baldwin led from Steve Moody and Chris Hackworth into turn 1 with Hackworth taking 2<sup>nd</sup> from Moody by turn 4. Baldwin and Hackworth opened up a small lead over Moody who had Ben Leslie, Dom Whiting and Ryan Ould lined up behind him. Hackworth dropped back a fraction on lap 2 after running through the puddle at turn 4, giving Baldwin a bit of a gap. Leslie got ahead of Moody going into turn 9 at the top of the hill and took Dom Whiting with him. Baldwin set a new fastest lap (1:32.051) on lap 3 to give himself a lead of 1.037 seconds over Hackworth, but Hackworth responded a lap later to close the gap to just 0.074 seconds as they crossed the line side-by-side with Hackworth taking the lead as the pair entered turn 1. Leslie was 6.151 seconds behind this battle, but was getting away from Whiting and Moody behind him in his efforts to secure 3<sup>rd</sup>. Hackworth then pulled away from Baldwin at half a second a lap to take the win from Baldwin by 1.698 seconds. Leslie took an easy 3<sup>rd</sup> with Whiting and Moody completing the top 5.

#### Heat 3

**Inters:** Michael Symons and Slawomir Piskorz led the field into turn 1 with Symons getting a gap half way around lap 1, only to lose it at turn 9, handing the lead to Patrick Ford with James Pratt 0.898 seconds behind him in 2<sup>nd</sup> and Slawomir Piskorz a further 0.6 seconds behind. Wolfgang Reip took over from Piskorz in 3<sup>rd</sup> with Joe Holmes following in his wheel tracks in 4<sup>th</sup>. Pratt was all over the back of Ford in the fight for the lead with Pratt getting ahead on lap 3. Ford came back at Pratt however, trying to get ahead going into turn 9, but running wide. This allowed Holmes and Reip to close up to make it a 4-kart train at the head of the field. Pratt started to edge away from Ford on lap 4 who had Holmes all over the back of him until the final corner where Holmes slipped up the inside of Ford for 2<sup>nd</sup>. Reip was slowly falling away from Ford and had Tim McKeegan closing in on the back of him as the started the final lap with just 0.225 seconds between them. Pratt took the win and the fastest lap, beating Holmes by 1.564 seconds. Ford took 3<sup>rd</sup> as McKeegan got the better for Reip to take 4<sup>th</sup> on the final lap.

**Heavies:** David Vincent hit the front at the start of heat 3 with Michael McKeegan close behind as the field shot down the hill. As the drivers reappeared, Chris Carter emerged in 3<sup>rd</sup> with Vincent having built a small lead over McKeegan behind him. Carter was closing in on McKeegan, getting on to his rear bumper at the start of lap 3 having set a new fastest lap. Ian Brooks joined McKeegan and Carter just as Carter lunged McKeegan going into the final







corner with Brooks setting a new fastest lap (1.34.613). Vincent was getting away from Carter who had not quite shaken off McKeegan and Brooks as the fastest lap fell to Vincent with 2 laps to go. Chris Munro had caught and passed lan Brookes and McKeegan on the penultimate lap as Vincent crossed the line with a 4.173 second lead. Vincent took the win from Carter who beat Munro to 2<sup>nd</sup> by 0.596 seconds. McKeegan took 4<sup>th</sup> and Brooks took 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Lights:** Tom Young led the field through the opening corners but lost out to James Wickham at turn 4. Wickham was soon joined by Aaron Kidd in the fight for the lead as the pair began to break away from the chasing pack which was headed by Dom Whiting at the end of lap 1. James Baldwin was into 4<sup>th</sup> on lap 2 having started at the back and took 3<sup>rd</sup> from Dominic Tucker through the final few corners. 2<sup>nd</sup> became 1<sup>st</sup> a lap later at the final corner as Baldwin passed Wickham, setting a new fastest lap as he crossed the line. Baldwin got his head down to build a lead over Wickham behind him as Wickham was being hounded by Mark Shulzhitsky and Chris Hackworth. Baldwin took a comfortable win from Shulzhitsky, Wickham, Hackworth and Steve Moody.

## Finals

**Inters:** James Pratt held onto the lead from pole as the green flag was dropped with Holmes getting stuck on the outside and dropping down from 2<sup>nd</sup>. Tim McKeegan moved into 2<sup>nd</sup> from 3<sup>rd</sup> into turn 1 with Tucker sitting in 4<sup>th</sup>. The full course yellows came out before the end of turn 1 to recover Anthony Ford's kart. Racing got back underway at the end of lap 2 with Pratt getting away from McKeegan and Holmes who was putting McKeegan under pressure to regain 2<sup>nd</sup>. Alec Tucker was next to challenge McKeegan as the trio of Holmes, McKeegan and Tucker got away from Wolfgan Reip in 5<sup>th</sup>. Pratt had a healthy lead of 5.572 seconds over the fight for 2<sup>nd</sup> which was still being head by Holmes who seemed to be gradually edging away from McKeegan and Tucker as these two fought for 3<sup>rd</sup>. Holmes continued to get away from McKeegan with McKeegan dropping Tucker as he tried to get back on terms with Holmes. Pratt took the chequered flag, 6.242 seconds clear of Holmes with Holmes setting the fastest lap of the race on the final lap. McKeegan, Tucker and Reip completed the top 5.

**Heavies:** David Vincent led from Chris Carter and Chris Munro into turn 1, with George Dutfield close behind in 4<sup>th</sup>. Vincent led Carter as the pair disappeared down the hill for the first time with Carter right in Vincent's slipstream as they re-emerged at the top of the hill. Carter then slipped passed Vincent into turn 9 to complete lap 1 in the lead. Munro was close behind Vincent with Dutfield on his rear bumper. Munro took up 2<sup>nd</sup> from Vincent coming out of the hairpin as Carter began to get away. Vincent wasn't going to give up on 2<sup>nd</sup> as he kept Munro honest whilst trying to keep Dutfield behind him. Ian Brooks was just 1.720 seconds behind running in a lonely 5<sup>th</sup> having gapped Robert Bennett. Munro put in a new fastest lap on lap 3 to give him a gap of 1.307 seconds over Vincent behind him close the gap to Carter ahead. Brooks was closing in on Dutfield but pushed too hard and slid wide at turn 9, dropping him down to 13<sup>th</sup>. Lap 5 saw Carter set a new fastest lap (1:33.392) and increased his lead to 4.255 seconds over Munro who had left Vincent to fend off Dutfield who was breathing down his neck for the final podium spot. Dutfield repeated Brooks' mistake in his pursuit of Vincent, sliding wide at turn 9 and allowing Vincent to have a clear run to 3<sup>rd</sup>. Carter took the win from Munro and Vincent with Dutfield and Bennett taking 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> respectively.

**Lights:** Chris Hackworth held onto the lead with James Baldwin getting alongside coming out to have a run on Hackworth going into turn 2. As Hackworth turned in, some contact occurred between him and Baldwin, causing Hackworth to bounce off of Baldwin and go off. This left Baldwin with the lead ahead of Johnny Spencer with Baldwin enjoy a lead of 2.876 seconds after the opening lap. Hackworth was fighting back and was into 4<sup>th</sup> by the end of lap 2, just a few kart lengths behind Ben Leslie in 3<sup>rd</sup>. Ryan Ould was up to 5<sup>th</sup> having started from the back due to a spin on the warm up lap, but was 3.470 seconds behind the fight for 3<sup>rd</sup> between Spencer, Leslie and Hackworth which was intensifying on lap 3. Hackworth got a run on Ben Leslie going into the hairpin on lap 3 and went for the move. Leslie turned in only to find Hackworth in his way leading to some minor contact allowing Hackworth up into 2<sup>nd</sup>. Baldwin made the most of this to pull a lead of 8.279 seconds over Hackworth who set a new fastest lap (1:30.767) on lap 4. His escape from the fight for 3<sup>rd</sup> between Spencer and Leslie was aided as the two began to swap positions allowing Dom Whiting to close in and join the fight for 3<sup>rd</sup>. Hackworth was taking chunks out of Baldwin's advantage, but Baldwin responded to hold the gap at 7 seconds for the final few laps. Baldwin took the







win from Hackworth by 6.796 seconds. Leslie completed the podium a further 10.499 seconds back. Whiting and Spencer completed the top 5.
